The Early Show – sponsored by Bell Atlantic

The Early Show 10 AM matinee series is a deeply discounted program that has made professional theatre affordable and accessible to both students and seniors throughout southern Maine for over fifteen years. Participants receive copies of the scripts for each production, resource guides with suggestions for pre- and post-show activities, and a subscription to *Prelude*, PSC's newsletter. Discussions with the cast immediately follow each matinee performance, providing an outlet for questions and ideas about the production, the theatrical process and the play itself.

Adopt-a-School – sponsored by Cole-Haan

The *Adopt-a-School* program was created collaboratively by the Portland Public School System and PSC during the 1992-93 season. Its goal is to uncover unique ways of using theatre in the classroom as a learning tool for the study of language, history, social science, visual and performing arts, science and technology. The *Adopt-a-School* program includes pre- and post-show workshops for every show in the season and in collaboration with teachers works to integrate theatre into the school curriculum. An internship at PSC offers rigorous training in all areas of theatre, opportunities to work with professional artists and administrators, hands-on experience in the operation of a professional arts organization, and the potential for developing and enhancing the skills necessary for a career in the theatre.

The Circle of Stars volunteer corps gives community members the opportunity to be part of the action at Portland Stage. There is always something to do around the theatre and we want to make every effort to find just the right place for your talents, your desire to learn about theatre, or your interest in meeting new people. Volunteers are needed in administration, hospitality, production support, special events and as ushers. If you're looking for a way to support the arts in our community, we welcome you to become a PSC volunteer!

The *Scholars on Stage* Humanities Series invites guest scholars from various humanities disciplines to illuminate the historical, social, political, cultural, and literary issues raised by each of the plays in PSC's mainstage season. *Scholars on Stage* allows audiences to explore the challenging questions often raised by PSC productions. These discussions are held following the first Sunday matinee of each production and are free and open to the public.

Curtain Call Discussions

A long-standing tradition at Portland Stage Company is the *Curtain Call Discussion* immediately following the second Sunday matinee performance of each play in the season. These post-performance discussions are free and open to the public, moderated by PSC's Director of Education and Outreach, and provide audiences an opportunity to discuss the production with the actors.

Pay-What-You-Can Night

The 9 PM performance on the first Saturday of each production is reserved exclusively for the Pay-What-You-Can program. Tickets may be purchased at the box office for any amount.

Rush Tickets

Based on availability, Rush Tickets may be purchased one hour prior to the start of a performance at half the regular ticket price.

Director's Notes



Culture of Desire, a world premiere happening here at Portland Stage, is a co-production with the City Theatre of Pittsburgh and the Saratoga International Theater Institute, and is presented in cooperation with the Andy Warhol Museum.

A new play asks crucial questions about what it means to live in our times. It is a reflecting pool in which we can see ourselves from different perspectives. The question at the heart of *Culture of Desire* is about consumerism. Many of us live in a constant state of desire for things: objects, wealth, fame. When did we transform from citizens of the United States of America to consumers of the United States of Amnesia? What does it mean personally, politically and spiritually to be treated as a lifetime consumer? How does it effect us to be born into a culture where the fulfillment of desire through the abnegation of individuality and responsibility is the norm? What does it do to a person to be treated as a consumer and not as a citizen?

In shaping *Culture of Desire*, Andy Warhol and the culture that created him was our access to this significant theme. He was and remains true to where the culture of desire has brought us. Andy Warhol made art from the present moment. He fetishized our culture and our desire and created art from it. Warhol became our metaphor and central figure because he projected the vast emptiness that reflects us profoundly.

The structure of *Culture of Desire* loosely follows Dante's journey through "The Inferno." In the middle of his life, Dante finds himself lost and disoriented. His hero, the poet Virgil, appears and offers to guide him through hell. Dante accepts and the adventures begin.

Following the allegory of Dante through hell, the scenes for *Culture of Desire* were written and staged by the SIT Company. The text is drawn from many sources including Dante's "Inferno," interviews with Andy Warhol and his contemporaries, writings on consumer culture, magazine articles and advertisements.

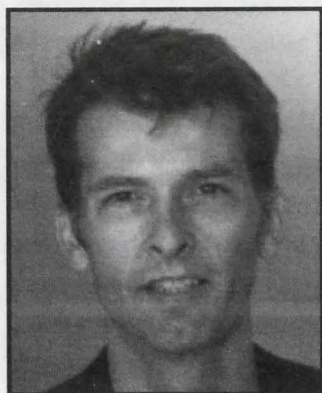

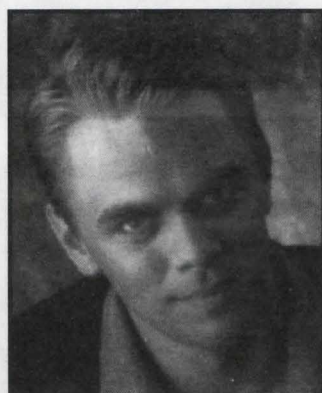
Who's Who in *Culture of Desire*
