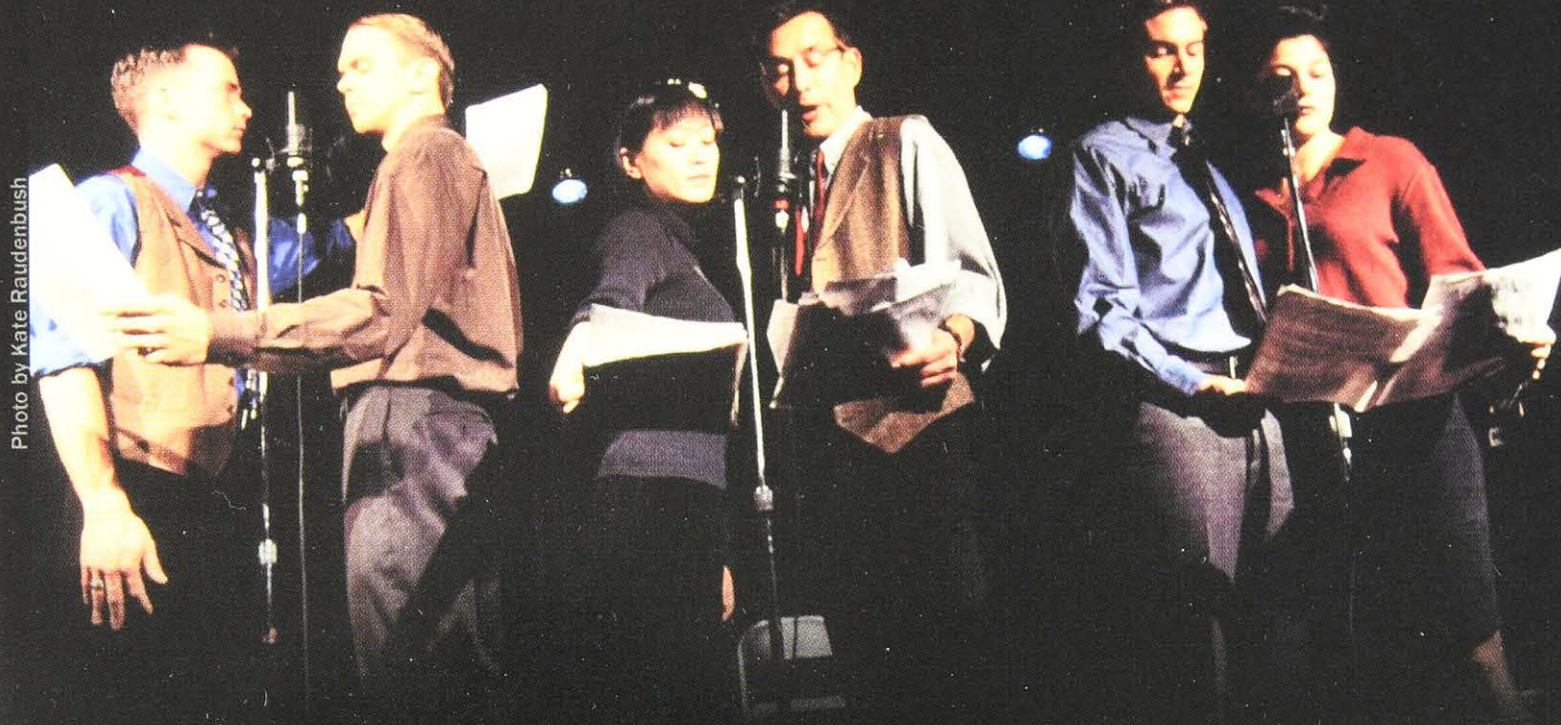

On the foggy fall evening of October 30, 1938, America went to war with Mars! Adapted from Orson Welles' Mercury Theater on the Air by Howard Koch, War of the Worlds is a program which terrified the nation. Now, nearly 70 years after the original broadcast, this radio classic comes to life as performed by SITI Company.

Founded in 1992 by Anne Bogart and Tadashi Suzuki, SITI Company began as an agreement to redefine and revitalize contemporary theater in the United States through an emphasis on international cultural exchange and collaboration. Originally envisioned as a summer institute in Saratoga Springs, New York, SITI expanded to encompass a year-round company based in New York City with a summer season in Saratoga. The Company is known nationally and internationally as a top-level artistic collective that generates ground breaking theater while training artist from around the world.

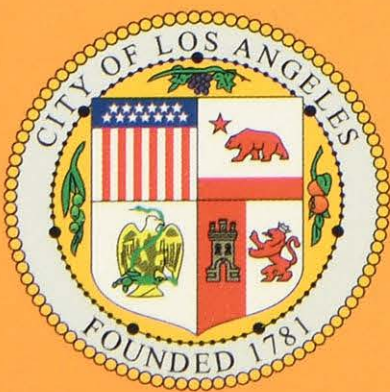
