... from Anne Bogart

As we head up to Saratoga Springs for our fourth SITI summer season, I find that I am more committed to SITI and our mission than ever before and that there is an ever increasing necessity for the existence of a company who's objective is not only to create new and vital work for the theater but to develop actor training and to encourage a fellowship of theater artists from around the world. The Company is artistically and spiritually stronger than it has ever been. We have two new works in rehearsal: *Going, Going, Gone* and *Short Stories*. Our recent residency in San Francisco with *The Medium* was a huge success. Enrollment in the training programs is through the roof. Ruth Ann Nightengale has come on board as our new Managing Director bringing with her a strong managerial background, dedication to the work of the company, a sense of humor, commitment, and patience. We are in the process of developing a strong board of directors.

SITI is at a significant turning point. In this expanding political climate where encouragement of artists and the support of art is not a priority, I believe that it is most important to make work with big heart and fierce objectives. I believe in the power and viability of a vital, strong human presence on the stage to encourage us through questionable times. And I believe that it is time for SITI to step forward and out into the world. We need your support more than ever before to help propel us through the next stage of our existence. We look for your support in person by attending *Going, Going, Gone* on July 20-22. We appreciate your talking about SITI's productions (which are ready to tour anywhere) to organizations which might present them. And finally, we absolutely need your financial contribution to help us get our two new productions onto the boards and to *keep us moving*. Thank you.



SITI MOVES - 1995

- In January, Actors Theatre of Louisville hosted a "Modern Masters" Celebration for Anne Bogart. Included in the celebration were productions of *The Medium* and *Small Lives/Big Dreams*. Anne and company members participated in a series of workshops, panel discussions, and symposia.
- Modus Ensemble produced *The Medium* in San Francisco for two weeks. The company gave 14 performances and five workshops. The theatrical community there was warm and welcoming – and very eager to have SITI return. It may be that SITI has found a West Coast home.
- SITI will be hosting Mr. Suzuki and several SCOT members in New York City for a collaborative weekend in late September. Workshops, panel discussions, and performances are currently being planned. Firm dates will be set before June 15. Watch your mailbox for more information.
- PS 122 hosted a two-week, sold-out run of *Small Lives/Big Dreams* in February.
- The SITI company successfully completed its six-week spring training session in New York City which was more popular than ever before. Over forty students participated in Viewpoint and Suzuki training, some taking class six days per week for six weeks.
- SITI has expanded the summer program at Skidmore College in Saratoga Springs. The four-week institute commenced on Monday, May 29 with 70 students from around the world. The entire SITI company serve as faculty.
- The institute will be followed by a four-week residency and rehearsal period which will conclude with the world-premiere of *Going, Going, Gone* on July 20-22. (Make your hotel reservations now!)
- Fall classes in New York City will begin in October. Calls come in daily from interested students around the country. Brochures and applications will be mailed out in mid-July.
