WHAT IS SITI?

SITI, The Saratoga International Theater Institute, was founded in 1992 by Anne Bogart and Tadashi Suzuki to redefine and revitalize contemporary theater in the United States through an emphasis on international cultural exchange and collaboration. Originally envisioned as a summer institute in Saratoga Springs, New York, SITI has expanded to encompass a year-round program based in New York City with a summer season in Saratoga.

SITI's three ongoing components are the creation of new work, the training of young theatre artists, and a commitment to forming partnerships with international collaborators. SITI believes that contemporary American theater must necessarily incorporate artists from around the world and learn from the resulting cross-cultural exchange of dance, music, art, and performance experiences.

SITI offers classes in two distinct methods of actor training: the Viewpoints and the Suzuki Actor Training Method. The SITI Company has been trained by the creators of these methods, Anne Bogart and Tadashi Suzuki, respectively, and are uniquely qualified to introduce and train other theater artists in these methods.

The Viewpoints

The Viewpoints grew out of the post-modern dance world as a way of creating structure for movement improvisation. Anne Bogart has adapted the Viewpoints from Mary Overlie and has expanded them for the theater to create bold and innovative new works. Through rigorous physical application of the Viewpoints, participants acquire an understanding of this unique vocabulary while aggressively exploring the boundaries of dance, music, and theater.

Classes available:

Basic Viewpoints, taught by the SITI Company, introduces the 12 Viewpoints and explores each separately and together leading to the integration of text and movement.

Intermediate Viewpoints is specifically for those who have already trained in the Viewpoints. This class will review the methodology, explore the Vocal Viewpoints, and work on short compositions. The SITI Company will lead the class, and Anne Bogart will be a weekly guest.

The Suzuki Actor Training Method

The Suzuki Method is a rigorous, physical discipline for actors created by world-renowned theater artist Tadashi Suzuki. Designed to regain the perceptive, expressive abilities and powers of the human body; the method strives to restore the wholeness of the body in a theatrical context. By drawing on traditional forms the training seeks "to create something transcending current practice in the modern theater."

Classes available:

Basic Suzuki, taught by the SITI Company, introduces the basic theories and movement combinations developed by Tadashi Suzuki.

Intermediate Suzuki, taught by the SITI Company, is specifically designed for those who have a working knowledge of the Suzuki technique. This class will be taught at a swift pace with occasional review of basic terminology. Limiting this class to experienced students only will allow for significant progress.
