plores the interface between news and entertainment, fact and fantasy, truth and imagination, both in Welles's work and in the competing narratives of his own life.

"There's something fascinating about the fact that Welles's fame began with such a powerful instance of the kind of confusion or blurring between news and entertainment that has come to haunt us through the last years of the century," says Bogart. "I think there was a loss of innocence for him at that moment which mirrors some-

thing much wider in our culture, something well worth exploring.

"And there's also been a lot of work recently portraying Welles's life as essentially comic or ridiculous," she adds. "But we really don't see it that way. To me, Welles is a true 20th century hero, a creator and an optimist to the last, a man who literally died at his typewriter, trying to pull together the next project. With this show, we want to get to the heart of his aesthetic and his time; and we think it's going to work."
