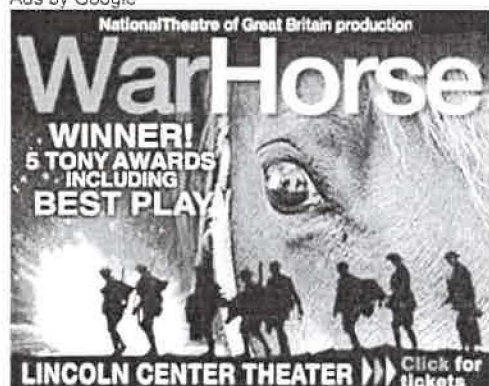

She's willing to wait 15 minutes or five years for that certain someone to walk into the cafe and change her life. He falls for her instantly — and literally, tray flying and table toppling.

Girl meets boy, over and over and over again in "Café Variations," director Anne Bogart's highly stylized, sometimes beguiling, and sometimes jarring musical theater piece that is making its world premiere at the Cutler Majestic Theatre. The book is a pastiche of fragments from the plays of Charles L. Mee Jr., Bogart's longtime collaborator. The subject, of course all its trite sweet nothings and ferocious partings. Thirty actors inhabit the stage, uncoupling to a score of reinvented old standards from the Gershwin canon. 

This isn't your tall-double-shot-no-whip-mocha-cash-and-carry cafe, b a set designed by Neil Patel, with lighting by Brian H. with a linear plot, but rather a collection of overheard conversations. It's small tea and raspberry tarts — with full-blown production numbers sprinkled in.

Two of the pairings, however, stand out. One is the bittersweet tale of Tilly (Debra Wilson) the gal in the blue dress waiting for someone to watch over her, and the stiff-backed Tom (Tom Nelis) who volunteers for the part. The other is the saga of Andrew (Leonid Kornyakov) and Edith (Ellen Lauren), an unlikely couple who meet, quarrel, and seduce each other in a ferocious game of cards.
