what is SITI?

SITI, The Saratoga International Theater Institute is an ensemble-based company whose three ongoing components are the creation of new work, the training of young theater artists, and a commitment to forming partnerships with international collaborators. The **SITI** company is comprised of director Anne Bogart and ensemble members J. Ed Araiza, Will Bond, Leon Ingulsrud, Ellen Lauren, Kelly Maurer, Jefferson Mays, Tom Nelis, Barney O'Hanlon, Karenjune Sanchez, Stephen Webber, Megan Wanlass, and Darron L. West.

SITI was founded in 1992 by **Anne Bogart** and **Tadashi Suzuki** to redefine and revitalize contemporary theater in the United States through emphasis on international exchange and collaboration. Originally envisioned as a summer institute in Saratoga Springs, New York, **SITI** has expanded to encompass a year-round program based in New York City with a summer season in Saratoga. **SITI** believes that contemporary American theater must necessarily incorporate artists from around the world and learn from the resulting cross-cultural exchange of dance, music, art, and performance experiences.
